## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

It has been found that manufacturers are using different types of permitted food acids such as citric acid, fumaric acid, malic acid and tartaric acid. Due to the different molecular weight of these acids, manufacturers are faced with the problem of conforming to the minimum limit of acidity specified in the standard.
