4 LABELLING AND MARKING

4.1 General Requirements

Delete the text “at least in English language” in **4.2.1**, and **4.2.2**.

Delete the 1st paragraph in **4.2.6**.

4.2.1 *Name of the product*

Delete the 2nd paragraph of **4.2.1** and substitute with the following:

5.2.1 “The product name shall be as approved by the Cosmetics, Devices and Drugs Authority and / or Department of Ayurveda, Sri Lanka and be declared in any two of the three languages (Sinhala, Tamil and English) including English.”

5.3 Language

Delete the entire text in **5.2** and substitute with the following:

5.3.1 The table upon which declarations in respect of the cosmetic contained in the package or container, shall be clearly and conspicuously displayed.

5.3.2 Where a label in any two of the three languages (Sinhala, Tamil and English) including English has been affixed on the main panel of such package or container of cosmetic and a supplementary label conforming to this specification appears conspicuously and prominently in bold type, in any one or more of the other two languages, indelibly printed or painted or affixed on any other panel of such package or container, it shall be satisfy the requirements of this specification.

5.3.3 The following declarations shall be in one or more of the three languages (Sinhala, Tamil and English) with the label or as a leaflet with the product.

- a) Brand name or trade name ;
- b) The name and address of the manufacturer / distributor/ importer including country of origin
- c) Batch number/ Identification code / Lot number ;
- d) List of ingredients ; and
- e) Date of manufacture and date of expiry ;

5.3.4 The following declarations shall be in two or more of the three languages (Sinhala, Tamil and English) including English with the label or as a leaflet.

- a) Directions for use of product and instruction for storage (if necessary) and
- b) Warning statements, when appropriate.
